

Tools for Clean Water in the Wilderness

Purified water is the foundation of survival in the wilderness, essential for hydration, cooking, first-aid, and hygiene. However, ensuring safe and reliable water requires the right tools and preparation. From purifying water on the go effectively and having the means to carry it over distances as you head to the next wild water location, having the proper gear can make all the difference between comfort and hardship.

In this article, we will cover four indispensable items for transforming contaminated water into clean water. These include the *GRAYL* Titanium water purification system, the *Campcraft Outdoors* water filter, the *CNOC Outdoors* water bag, and the *SILVERANT Outdoors* Titanium water bottle. With these tools in your pack, you will be ready to face the challenges of wilderness travel while staying hydrated and healthy.

Items to Pack

1. **GRAYL** Titanium Water Purification System (the Outer Shell and Lid can be used for gathering water and boiling as well as for cooking specific meal types). [Holds 0.2 gallons.](#)
2. **SILVERANT Outdoors** Titanium Water Bottle (carrying clean water and boiling unpurified water, and the carrying strap allows for easy carry outside of one's backpack). The Cup holds ½ cup to drink from or use for measuring water for food prep. [Holds 0.4 gallons.](#)
3. **Campcraft Outdoors** Filter Bag (removes visual particulates from water before purification, extending the life of purification system cartridges).
4. **CNOC Outdoors** Water Bag (with its easy roll-up storage and a wide opening at the end to ease filling). [Holds 0.5 gallons.](#)



Water Plan: You **must** consider the water you carry as your only available supply. Once available water is half depleted, you **must** confirm that your plan for restock is valid; if it is not, you **must** return to the previous source. **Plan** to have some water remaining when reaching your restock point.
